WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (such as a computer or smartphone) when you visit a website. They contain information about your interaction with the website, allowing it to remember your preferences and actions over time. This functionality enhances your browsing experience by saving settings and preferences for future visits.

Cookies serve various purposes, including storing login information, language settings, and other preferences. They are essential for the functioning of the website and improving user experience. Additionally, cookies can track user behavior, helping website owners optimize functionality and content.

Cookies can be set by the website you are visiting (first-party cookies) or by other services (third-party cookies) authorized by the website to provide additional content, run features like analytics and advertising, and track user interactions across different sites.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

2. **Optional Cookies:** While not necessary for basic website functions, these cookies significantly enhance your user experience. They include:
 - a) **Functional & Performance Cookies:** These cookies improve the website's performance and functionality by remembering your preferences and settings, such as login details and language choices. Disabling these cookies may result in a less personalized browsing experience.
 - b) **Analytics Cookies:** These cookies collect information on how visitors interact with our website, such as pages visited, time spent on the site, and traffic sources. This data helps us understand user

behavior and improve website performance. They enable us to track and analyze metrics to identify areas for improvement.

c) **Marketing & Advertising Cookies:** These cookies make advertising more relevant to your interests by preventing the same ad from appearing too frequently, ensuring ads are displayed correctly, and sometimes selecting ads based on your interests. Advertising cookies help us and our partners deliver tailored advertisements, enhancing the relevance of the marketing content you receive.
